Richard (Rick) Townsend, 72 years of age, passed away peacefully and went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, January 31, 2024. He was preceded in death by his parents Buford Townsend and Tommie Jo Townsend.

Rick was born in Paris, Texas on July 9, 1951. He graduated from Bryan Adams High School in 1969. At the age of 18, he joined the police academy and spent his 20 year law enforcement career with the Dallas Police Department. 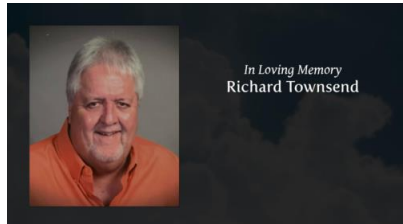

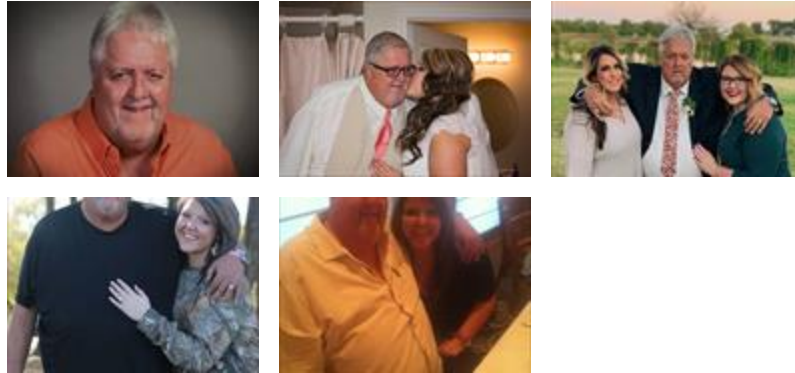
