August 16, 1943 - February 16, 2025

James Ronald “Ronnie” Moore, longtime resident of Terrell, passed away on Feb. 16, 2025. Ronnie was born on Aug. 16, 1943 at home in Kaufman, Texas to L.D. and Golda Moore, both of whom preceded him in death along with his siblings: Fred Moore, Peggy Sue Parker and Shirley Chambers.

Ronnie attended, and graduated from, Terrell schools after which he served in the Army National Guard and then also worked at the Nike Missile Base in Terrell for many years. On March 28, 1968, he married a lovely woman whom he loved dearly named Patty and they would be inseparable for over five decades. Ronnie also worked at Home Depot in Mesquite and retired after 25 years of faithful employment. When not working, he enjoyed being home and watching westerns as well as going anywhere to fish.
