



## Roy Webb Jr.

January 21, 1946 - June 25, 2018

Roy W. Webb, Jr., lifetime resident of Terrell, passed away from this earthly life on June 25, 2018 to be reunited with his beloved wife, Judy, and his son, Scott, both of whom preceded him in death along with his parents, Roy, Sr. and Betty (Simpson) Webb, sisters: Dorothy Wright and Vivian Monk; and nephew, Thomas Ethier. His skills of being a competent leader garnered him the reputation of fair in every matter personally and professionally. 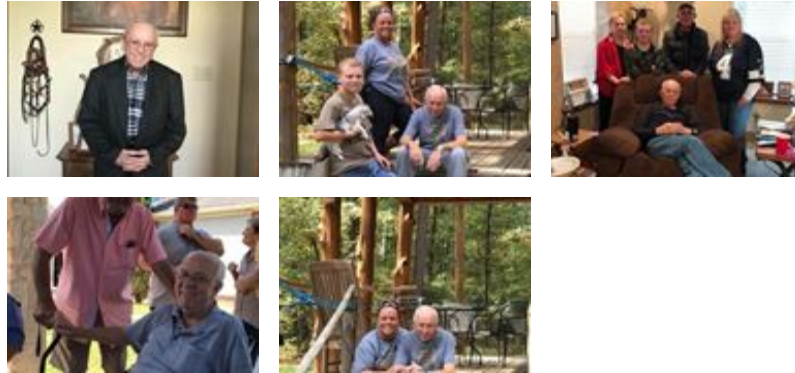

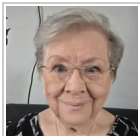
