Melba Ruth Ratliff Gardner Lee, 91, went to be with the Lord on Feb. 19, 2017. Funeral service will be held at 10:30am, Wednesday, Feb. 22, 2017 at Max Slayton Funeral Chapel with Rev. She enjoyed league bowling and fishing with Roy. She liked working in her yard and just being outside enjoying all of God's creations. She was always a hard worker and her work ethic is a legacy she passed on to each generation of her family. Ruth's faith was very important to her and she was a faithful member of East End Missionary Baptist Church, now known as First Missionary Baptist Church, since 1957. She was such an inspiration to her family: so kind, loving, thoughtful and always putting everyone else first. She loved everyone and chose to see the best in each person that she met and knew. She was a positive person and she loved her

family dearly. Ruth and Linda had a special mother/daughter relationship and both considered each day a new opportunity to talk, visit, remember, plan and just share the day's events with each other. Ruth will be truly missed but leaves precious memories to be cherished by all who knew and loved her. Ruth was preceded in death by her husband, J.W. Gardner; parents, Carnie and Myrtle Ratliff, Sr.; husband, Roy L. 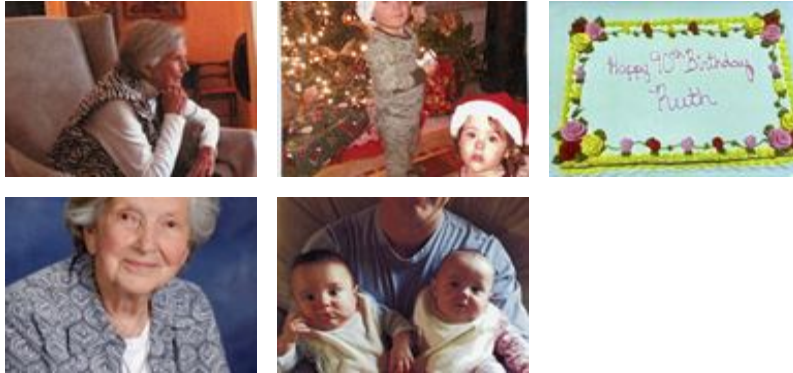
