



Dr. Scott Ervin

May 22, 1964 - May 3, 2025

Dr. Scott A. Ervin, DDS, of Rockwall, Texas, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday evening, May 3, 2025. He was 60 years old.

Scott was born in Garland, Texas, on May 22, 1964, to Charlotte A. Ervin and the late James L. “Jim” Ervin. He spent the last 19 years in Rockwall, where he was a devoted father, friend, neighbor, and an active member of the community. Prior to moving to Rockwall, Scott lived in Terrell, Texas, where he established and operated a successful dental practice known for its welcoming environment, excellent care, and lasting patient relationships. His warm demeanor and gentle chairside manner made him a beloved figure among his patients and colleagues alike.

Scott’s love for sports began early in life. He attended South Garland High School in Garland, Texas, before moving to Lake Forest High School in Lake Forest, Illinois, where he graduated and proudly played both football and basketball. His competitive spirit and team-oriented mindset stayed with him throughout his life. Scott remained an avid sports fan, following his favorite teams—the Texas Rangers and the Arkansas Razorbacks—with unmatched enthusiasm just like his late father, Jim Ervin. He was also a devoted fantasy football participant, playing every season and earning a reputation among friends and family for knowing nearly everything about the NFL. Sundays in the fall were a sacred tradition, often filled with football, food, and friendly competition. Scott had a zest for life and a wide range of interests. He enjoyed cycling, running, swimming, golfing, hunting, and competing in triathlons—

activities that reflected his driven, adventurous spirit.

A graduate of Abilene Christian University in 1986, Scott earned his Bachelor's degree in Biology and was a proud member of the Sub T-16 fraternity, where he forged lifelong friendships and developed his values of service, integrity, and leadership. He went on to earn his DDS from Baylor College of Dentistry in 1990. Driven by a love for dentistry and a passion for teaching, Scott served as a part-time clinical instructor at Baylor from 1992 to 2005, mentoring and shaping the next generation of dental professionals. Professionally, Scott was highly respected in his field. He held memberships in the American Dental Association®, the Southwest Academy of Restorative Dentistry, the Academy of Operative Dentistry, and the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Honor Society. Throughout his career, he was known for his pursuit of excellence and his desire to make a meaningful impact—not just in his patients' oral health, but in their overall well-being.

Scott was deeply devoted to his family. He is survived by his beloved children: Seth, Sydnee, Sarah, and Sophee Ervin, who were the center of his world. His pride in their accomplishments and character was evident to all who knew him. He is preceded by his father Jim Ervin and he is also survived by his loving mother, Charlotte Ervin; his sisters and their spouses: Elizabeth and Rick Schweik, and Courtney and Rob Kraner; and his nieces and nephews: Keaton Kraner, Kylie Kraner, Koen and wife Melissa Kraner, Connor and wife Sarah Schweik, and Griffin Schweik. He cherished his extended family, including numerous relatives. He also leaves behind his special friend, Mary Garcia, whose companionship brought joy, comfort, and light to his later years. A man of strong faith, Scott was an active member of Lake Pointe Church in Rockwall. His belief in serving others extended beyond the church and into the community, where he frequently donated his time and expertise. One of his proudest contributions was his participation in Dentists with A Heart Day, during which he provided free dental care to underserved individuals—just one of many ways he quietly gave back.

Scott will be remembered not only for his professional accomplishments, but

for the way he lived—with humility, humor, generosity, and unwavering dedication to the people and communities he loved. His legacy is one of compassion, commitment, and love—a life well lived and deeply missed. A gathering of friends and family will be held on Friday, May 9, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. The main service will be held immediately following the gathering at 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. at First Baptist Church, 403 N Catherine St, Terrell, TX 75160. The service will be open to the public. Following the service, Scott will be laid to rest in Granbury, Texas, beside his father and grandparents.
