On Saturday, February 20, 2021, Sean Melton of Kemp, Texas, passed away at the age of 36.

He was born on July 4th, 1984 to Steaven and Joy Melton and graduated from Mineola High School in 2002. Sean served as a police officer for the Richardson Police Department where he was honored to protect and serve his community. Sean attended the University of Missouri-Columbia Business Management from 2007 to 2010 after which he returned to Texas to begin working as a police officer for the Richardson Police Department where he was honored to protect and serve his community.
