Dumbledore quote from the Harry Potter movies was “Happiness can be found, even in the darkest of times, if only one remembers to turn on the light.”

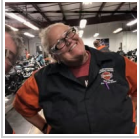

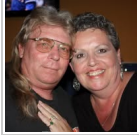
