Sheri Scott Snell was born June 16, 1953 in Longview Texas to James and Merlene Scott. She was the third of three girls. She departed this life February 21, 2017 at home surrounded by her family. She was preceded in death by her father, J.B. Scott.

Burnett Elementary and Junior High school provided Sheri's early education. She was a 1971 graduate of Terrell High School and attended Southwestern Christian College from 1971-1973.

While a student at Southwestern Christian College, she met, fell in love and married a fellow student, Eddie Snell. To this union, one son was born, Scott Marcus Snell. Sheri adopted her infant granddaughter, JaToi Chyne Snell, shortly after her birth.

Sheri accepted Christ as her Savior and put him on in baptism as a teenager. She was a faithful member of the West End Street Church of Christ in Terrell Texas. When at home in Arlington, Texas, she attended the New York Avenue Church of Christ.

She worked for the City of Terrell before moving to Arlington, Texas, where she was employed by the US Postal Service for many years before retiring. Sheri loved taking road trips, and like her father, was an avid sports fan who dearly loved her Dallas Mavericks and Cowboys.
