Thomas Hathcock, longtime resident of Terrell, passed away on Feb. 18, 2022 in Mesquite. Tom was born April 7, 1949 in Ennis, Tx to Harley and Donnie Hathcock, both of whom preceded him in death along with his son, Tim Hathcock, and brother, Travis Hathcock.

Tom attended Hutchins schools growing up and, while in church, he met a beautiful young lady named Faye Cox. They married had a beloved son, Tim, while Tom owned and operated automotive businesses. He was a successful entrepreneur in Terrell being best known for Toms Paint and Body but he also owned and operated a mechanic's shop fixing radiators and general repair.

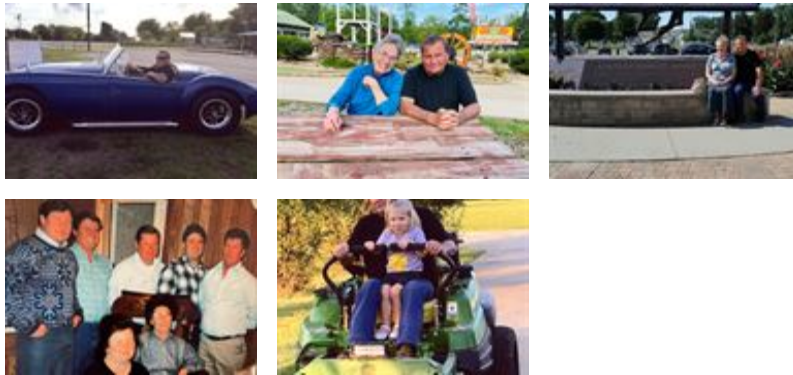
