Thomas Ray Hagler, age 70, passed away on October 12, 2021 at his home in Terrell, TX. He was born April 19, 1951 in Uvalde, TX to John and Shirley Hagler. Tommy was raised in Kaufman, TX and graduated from Terrell High School in 1970.

Tommy was an experienced horseman who loved his family, dogs, horses and most of all he loved to rope. He honed his veterinary skills when he worked at Terrell Veterinary Clinic for Doctors Lewis and Brittain. He became a certified farrier at Oklahoma State Horseshoeing School in 1977 and shod horses in Kaufman and surrounding counties for years.

He also trained quarter horses for Governor Bill Clements and won many quarter horse shows including the World Champion Quarter Horse show for Heading in 1979 and Heeling in 1981. He was an avid roper and spent many hours at jackpot roping's and the practice pen at home.

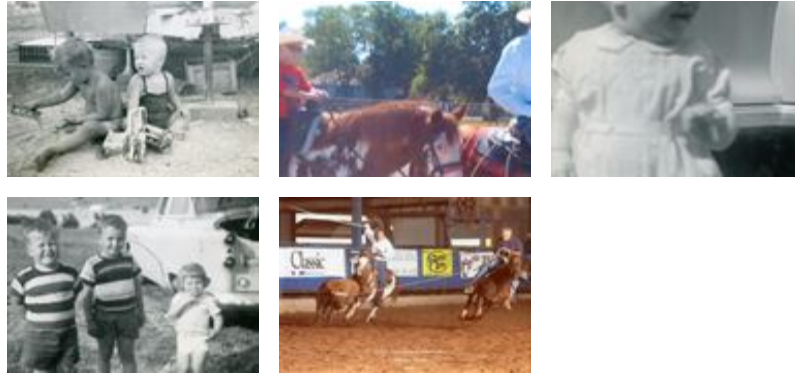
