



## Tony Eakin

August 19, 1945 - June 3, 2023

Mark Anthony (Tony) Eakin, of Terrell, passed away peacefully on June 3, 2023. Tony was born on August 19, 1945 in Orange, TX to John Herbert and Margaret (Prycer) Eakin, both of whom preceded him in death along with his brother, John Prycer Eakin and sister, Becky Ann Eakin Simmons.

After graduating high school, Tony enlisted into the US Army where he honorably served during the Vietnam War. After his honorable discharge, Tony married the love of his life, Maureen Donovan, on September 18, 1971. Tony gained his Bachelors then Master's degree in Education Administration and, in 1977 he began working with Terrell ISD as an elementary PE teacher while Maureen taught down the road at Wills Point ISD. They were blessed with their son, James, who completed their lives as they each served their campuses and communities. The many students (and later parents of students) recognized him around town from PE classes and riding the bus during the school year. 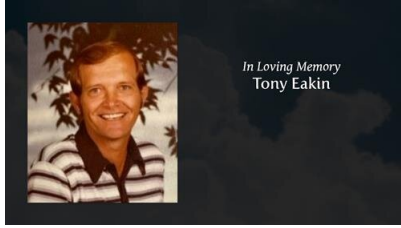
