William Johnson Wallace, of Terrell, passed away on May 5, 2019. William was born May 3, 1935 in Terrell to Matthew and Helen (Johnson) Wallace, both of whom met him in Heaven along with his wife, Willie Mae Wallace, sister, Mattie Baker; brothers: Matthew “June” Wallace, Jr., Edgar Wallace, and Henry Wallace. William was a lifelong resident of the Terrell area where he attended schools. He enlisted in the Army where he served honorably. He married Willie Mae Bell and they were inseparable until her passing in 2012. In 1934, William’s father opened the Wallace Airfield (on the west end of Town on Hwy 80) and, as a result, William developed a lifelong love and passion for planes and all things flight related. After the Airfield closed, William opened Wallace Produce Stand in 1985 on the grounds of the original airfield. William was a member of First Baptist Church in Terrell and will be greatly missed by his family and friends.
