Wilma Lucille Jones, lifetime resident of Terrell, passed peacefully into the presence of her Lord and Savior, whom she loved and served, on October 6, 2025. Wilma was born August 27, 1943 to her parents, Harlen and Lucille Jahnes, both of whom joyfully welcomed her into Heaven along with her husband, Murrell Jones, and brother, Norman Jahnes.

Wilma attended Terrell schools and graduated in 1961 from Terrell High School where she was involved in many activities including cheerleading. Her personality and academic accomplishments helped her be a vibrant part of the student body with many friends among the students and staff. Wilma began working for American National Bank in Terrell, until retiring, with her most recent position as BSA Analyst II. For over 41 years, her smiling, helpful and patient demeanor was cherished by coworkers and customers alike.

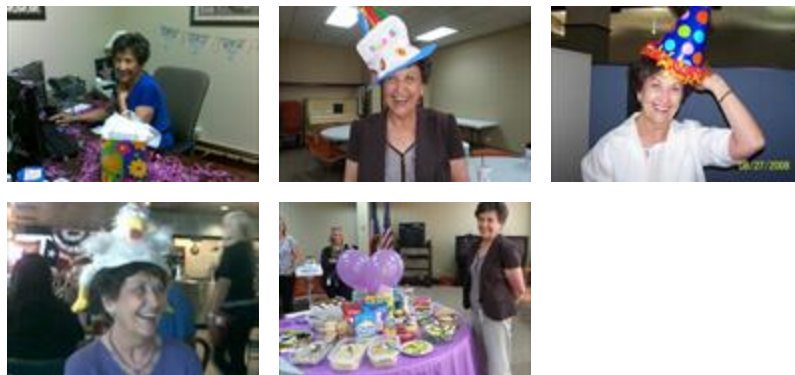
